Legislative Report by Nathalie Walker, MBA, RN, CNOR

National Legislative Forum

Purpose

This group is a membership assembly convened via monthly conference call by AORN Government Affairs staff to coordinate and support AORN's health policy initiatives. The National Legislative Forum is open to all AORN members with an interest in health policy and legislative affairs.

Initiatives

- 1. Continue to strengthen and expand state-level relationships
- 2. Advance RN Circulator legislation
- 3. Protect perioperative nursing scope of practice
- 4. Seek reimbursement parity for RNFAs
- 5. Advocate for safe work environments (smoke evacuation and safe patient handling)
- 6. Provide advocacy training to AORN members
- 7. Ensure perioperative nursing voice in federal reform efforts

<u>Senate bill 31</u>, which would require an RN Circulator for the duration of a procedure in every Vermont operating room, unanimously passed out the Senate Health and Welfare Committee last week after AORN worked with stakeholders on an amendment to make the requirement applicable to ASCs in addition to hospitals. AORN Government Affairs Manager, Danielle Glover, and AORN member Christina McCaffrey <u>previously testified</u> in the Committee in support of S.31. The bill then went to the <u>Senate floor</u> for vote where it passed on March 3, 2017. Prior to the Senate floor vote, AORN and ANA-Vermont asked members to contact Senators to encourage them to vote in favor of the legislation. The communication from constituents and practicing professionals was impactful.

Now that S.31 has made it out of the Senate, the House will take up the legislation in the coming months.

AORN Government Affairs will continue to advocate for S. 31 and it's companion bill, H126, and provide updates on their progression. 
